



Role: Counselor In Training

Department: Teen Staff Program

Description: Gain valuable camp experience as you are paired up with one of our full-time Counselors to learn what it takes to lead a small group of Day Campers. Bond with the rest of the Teen Staff team through training, during camp, at Bible studies and meetings. A volunteer position for those who wish to serve campers and get an understanding of what goes on at camp. Must commit to at least one full week of camp and the training session.

Areas of Responsibility:

Day Camp

- Arrive by 7:30am on Monday to help with set up
- Arrive by 8:00am for the rest of the week
- Stay until the last camper is picked up and the pick-up program has been cleaned up (usually around 5:00pm)
- Debrief at the end of each day with the Teen Staff Coordinator
- Paired up with one counselor and a group of up to 10 campers for the week
- Assist counselor with activities and supervision of group of campers

Family Camp

- Assist in the morning and evenings with the Kids Club (elementary age)

Other

- One full day of training in Day Camp activities and curriculum

Requirements:

- At least 14 years old
- Love for children
- Love for Jesus and willing to share your faith with campers, while also setting a Godly example
- Willing to commit to volunteer for at least one full week
- Application on file and short interview with either the Program Specialist or Teen Staff Coordinator

Accountability and Support: Teen Staff Coordinator and Program Specialist
